




This approach did justice to the name of the brand "holostik" by bringing together the company physically as a structure and the people belonging to it.






typical floor plan of the iconic tower demonstrating the sustainable characteristic of well working cross ventilated units along with their unique feature of unrestricted views in every unit.

the pavilion celebrates the coming together of space, material and light to create experiences in architecture that are cognitive of the indian civilization. working on a structure of a un shelter pavilion, the terracotta intervention addresses the larger picture to symbolize what happens 'after the aftermath' of a disaster - a narrative of the journey beyond, the structure integrates into the fabric of boisbuchet's site and respectfully embraces markus heinsdorff's existing design for a refugee's shelter.

it creates a platform for public communication that celebrates the original concept as a symbol for humanity. at the same time, the pavilion in its materiality, refers to the historical red bricks in the close-by walls of the historic barn, while its layout suggests a meandering topography in harmony with the spiral motif of boisbuchet's 19th century park.
